

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A GENERAL PURPOSE MUNICIPAL EXCISE TAX OF THREE PERCENT (3%) ON ALL SALES WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES WHICH ARE TAXABLE UNDER THE OKLAHOMA SALES TAX CODE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CARLTON LANDING, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. A general purpose municipal excise tax of three percent (3%) is hereby levied upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales within the municipal boundaries which are taxable under the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code, to be used for general purposes of the Town of Carlton Landing.


SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPROVAL BY TOWN VOTERS REQUIRED. The provisions of Section 1 shall become effective from and after 12:00 A.M. on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2014, but only if this ordinance is approved prior to said date by a majority vote of the qualified, registered voters of the Town of Carlton Landing voting on such question at a Special Town Meeting to be held for that purpose pursuant to the Oklahoma Town Meeting Act; provided if this Ordinance is not so approved by Town voters prior to 12:00 A.M. on April 1, 2014, then the provisions of Section 1 shall become null and void and of no force and effect whatever.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY SECTION. WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Trustees it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, welfare and safety of the Town of Carlton Landing, Oklahoma, Oklahoma and of the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage as provided by law.
