ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CARLTON LANDING TO TAKE ACTIONS NECESSARY OR DESIRABLE TO OBTAIN AND OPERATE A LEASE OF LANDS OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, TO EXERCISE JURISDICTION AND CONTROL OVER SUCH LANDS WHETHER WITHIN OR WITHOUT THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES, AND AUTHORIZING RELATED ACTIONS; REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CARLTON LANDING, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. The Town of Carlton Landing is hereby authorized, to the full extent permitted by state and federal law, to do and take all actions necessary or desirable to apply for, obtain, execute, comply with, maintain and operate a lease of lands owned or controlled by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (the "USACE"), and to exercise jurisdiction and control over such lands, whether within or without the Town boundaries, to the extent consented to or authorized by the USACE. Related actions authorized by this Section include, but are not limited to:

- A. the provision, establishment, construction, operation and maintenance of public park and recreational facilities as contemplated by Title 11, Section 33-101, et seq., of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- B. the sublease of parts of or all of the lands leased from the USACE to public or private entities as authorized by the USACE;
- C. subject to the limits of Article 10, Section 26 and other provisions of the Oklahoma Constitution, the expenditure of public funds upon the leased lands and/or in furtherance of agreements with the USACE.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY SECTION. WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Trustees it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, welfare and safety of the Town of Carlton Landing, Oklahoma, Oklahoma and of the inhabitants thereof that the

provisions of this ordinance be put into full force and effect immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage as provided by law.
