 The meeting was called to order at 8:02 a.m., with Mayor Chinnici presiding.

Resident Grant Humphreys noted that the resolution is a preliminary step towards setting up a review committee for consideration of the proposed tax increment financing (TIF) district, and it will be used to notify the taxing jurisdictions to appoint representatives to the review committee, that will review potential projects for the TIF district and make recommendations to the board of trustees. It was noted that the resolution not bind the Town to form the TIF district or adopt a particular project plan, but it sets the process in motion. A discussion was had on the role of the proposed TIF district in providing public improvements to promote faster and higher quality private investment and development. Trustee McCollum inquired about the likely review committee appointees from the taxing jurisdiction. Grant Humphreys responded that the taxing jurisdictions will be able to choose their appointments.
