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ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT FOR ENTITIES REQUIRED TO COLLECT SALES TAX UNDER STATE LAW; REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

**ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CARLTON LANDING, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1.

- (a) All entities required to collect sales tax under state law, located or doing business within the Town Boundaries, shall maintain a current registration with the Town as provided by this section.
- (b) The registration required by this section shall be accomplished by delivery of a copy of the sales tax permit issued to the entity by the Oklahoma Tax Commission or by delivery of a document containing the following minimum information:
  - (1) The name, address, business location, and a brief description of the business conducted by the entity; and
  - (2) The entity's sales tax permit number.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance are severable and if any part or provision hereof shall be adjudged invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect or impair any of the remaining parts or provisions.
